- Professional experience (post-M.Sc. 8-10 years; post-PhD 3-5 years) in the field of wildlife conservation in India and abroad, especially in high-altitude ecosystem of the Indian Himalayas

- Post-doctorate in the field of ecology / wildlife conservation from a recognized institution
- Experience in field-based ecological and community-based conservation projects, especially in context of Indian Himalayan and Trans-Himalayan ecosystem
