

## Surgical Veterinarian for Free-ranging Dogs Sterilization/ABC Programme in Ladakh

**Details about the job opening:** The Bombay Natural History Society, Indian's Oldest NGO engaged in conservation of Nature is working on free-ranging dogs' mitigation through sterilization/ABC programme in bordering areas (Changthang Wildlife Sanctuary, Karakoram Wildlife Sanctuary, Hemis National Park, Leh and Kargil and Drass) of Ladakh under the project "**On a war footing: Biodiversity monitoring and conservation with Indian Army in Ladakh**" to conserve the endemic and endangered wildlife in the region. The work will be conducted under the coordination of Animal Husbandry Department, Ladakh.

**Job Specification for Veterinarian:** The selected person should have a first-class bachelor's / Master's degree from recognized University/Institution in Veterinary Science. He / She Should have minimum two years of experience. The candidate should have an interest in wildlife conservation and should be prepared to work independently. Persons with extensive clinical experience in working with free-ranging dogs and wild animals will be preferred. The candidate should be physically fit for the fieldwork in remote locations.
