HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INDIAN SKIMMER COUNT

- Visit any of the short-listed sites from here or any other sites of your choosing either on 04th January or 05th January, 2025 or both the dates

- Upload your counts to the <u>eBird mobile app</u>, Please see this <u>PDF</u> that provides step by step procedure to upload your skimmer counts using the eBird Mobile app. Once uploaded, please share the checklist with the user ID- <u>Indian Skimmer</u> or email ID <u>skimmercount@bnhs.org</u> (Refer to this <u>article</u> on how to share a checklist.)
- If possible, undertake a careful count of Juvenile, Immature and Adults. See here for understanding age classification. To learn about how to edit and add additional information in your checklists, see here
