



LOCATIONS VISTED DURING THE COUNT

ABOUT THIS INITIATIVE

The aim of the Indian Skimmer Count is to gather information about the Indian Skimmer *Rynchops albicollis* population across its distribution range. It is conducted in two phases by Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) in association with Bird Count India. In

January 2022 the event saw participation from birdwatchers, photographers and other citizens from India and Bangladesh who surveyed various sites and contributed their valuable data. Skimmers were recorded at 8 sites in India and one site in Bangladesh
